The Goldstein Scottish Rite Trust is pleased to offer one \$1,000 scholarship to a deserving student seeking a degree or certification in a vocational or technical trade in the 2018-19 academic year.

Attached is this year's higher education scholarship application for the Goldstein Scottish Rite Trust Scholarship for vocational and technical students. The application consists of personal information, educational plans, official transcripts, letter(s) of recommendation, school acceptance letter(s), and a personal essay. To qualify for a Goldstein Scholarship, applicants must be (or soon to be) a graduate of a Juneau-Douglas area school (including HomeBridge or a G.E.D. program). This scholarship is solely for students seeking a degree or certification in a vocational or technical trade. Preference will also be given to students continuing their education at an accredited school in the State of Alaska.

<u>PERSONAL ESSAY</u>: This essay is to be ONLY one typed page, using standard fonts, margins and formatting. Describe your educational goals and objectives for your vocational or technical study program, your plans and time frame for meeting these goals, and your plans for utilizing your education after you receive your degree or certificate. Be as specific as possible about your goals and objectives, and the reasons you are choosing this form of higher education and subsequent career path. The essay is important and weighs heavily in the selection process.

<u>OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS</u> or equivalent G.E.D. test results, including SAT or ACT test scores if available. They must indicate that you have graduated or will graduate this year from a Juneau-Douglas area school or G.E.D program.

<u>LETTER(S) OF RECOMMENDATION</u> Submit up to three letters of recommendation from school officials or employers attesting to your ability and desire to be successful in your educational goals.

<u>LETTER(S) OF ACCEPTANCE</u> Submit a copy of any acceptance letters you have received to vocational and/or technical schools to which you have applied to attend.

What is the Goldstein Trust Scholarship?

The Goldstein Trust was established in 1945 by Juneau Entrepreneurs Charles Goldstein and James Cooper, owners of the Goldstein Improvement Company. It was established to provide financial assistance to young men and women of the Juneau area for higher educational purposes.

It set aside a portion of the annual earnings from the Goldstein Improvement Company into a separate account to be used as the principal for the scholarship. Interest and investment earnings above a minimum required value are distributed each year to scholarship recipients to assist in their higher educational expenses.

From its formation, the Goldstein Trust has been administered by the Scottish Rite Bodies of Juneau. It is awarded to those students, male or female, who have financial need, have graduated from a Juneau area school, and who have been accepted into a vocational and/or technical school.

The personal essay written by the applicant is given significant weight in the selection process. Race, color, creed, and fraternal affiliations are not considered in the selection of scholarship recipients. Students receiving Goldstein Trust Scholarship funds are under no obligation to repay any of the assistance awarded to them by this Trust.
